Mortgage Paydown

The next balloon payment on our mortgage is due July 16, 2024, with no further extensions allowed. It's either pay it off in full now or apply for a new mortgage at a significantly increased interest rate.

On January 25, 2024, an appeal letter was sent to our members, asking for donations toward our remaining mortgage balance of \$11,245.

We are thrilled to announce that as of the third week of February, we have raised \$8,020 toward our mortgage balance. An anonymous donor has also offered us an unrestricted matching donation of up to \$10,000 if we raise just \$1,980 more! Once the last bit is paid off, we will finally own our home outright! Funds raised above the goal will go toward the many needs of our historic building (roof, basement repairs, etc.) After 40 years of diligent effort, what began as a dream for Garrison Players to own its own building is within our sights.

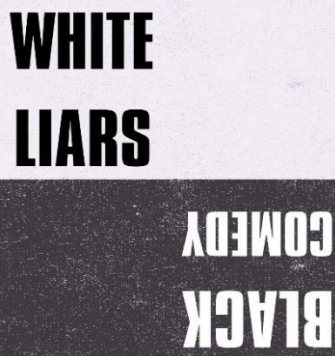

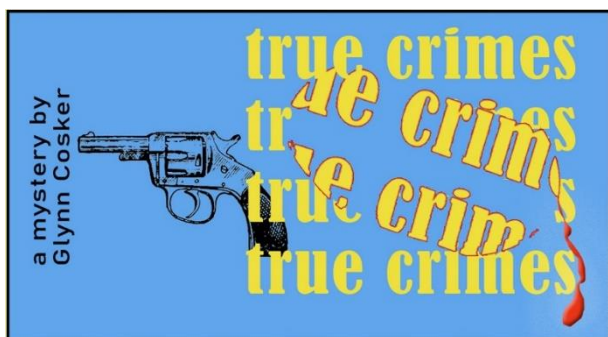
